As part of its ongoing commitment to understanding the magnitude, scope and determinants of adverse events in Canadian jurisdictions, and identifying, implementing and evaluating leading practices and/or tools that have been proven to improve patient safety, the Canadian Patient Safety Institute (CPSI) has launched its second research Grants Competition.

The inaugural competition in 2005 funded 16 research and 12 demonstration projects across the country. CPSI will be accepting proposals for the same two streams in the 2006 competition.
