



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS IPAC CANADA EDUCATION CORE COMMITTEE

Two Experienced ICPs for Three Year Term One Novice ICP for One Year Term

Responsibilities of the Education Core Committee include facilitating the development of educational opportunities for IPAC Canada members, other than the annual national education conference. A national Scientific Program Committee is appointed for the purposes of developing the conference program(s). The Chair and Co-Chair of the Education Core Committee work closely with the Executive Director of IPAC Canada in the facilitation of educational opportunities, the functioning of the Core Committee, and communication with Chapter representatives.

Two (2) Experienced ICPs for a Three Year Term – IPAC Canada is seeking two experienced ICP members of the Education Core Committee. The volunteer position commences July 1, 2017 and ends on June 30, 2020. Reappointment is at the discretion of the Chair of the Education Core Committee.

Qualifications:

- The applicant has been a member of IPAC Canada for at least 3 years.
- A current CIC® is preferred but not mandatory.
- Membership must be maintained in good standing during the term of this position.
- The applicant will have expertise in infection prevention and control, with a minimum of three years of experience.
- The applicant will have experience in the development of education opportunities in the following preferred but not mandatory settings: distance education, classroom, webinar.
- The applicant will have experience with working as a team member, with strong collaboration, communication and organizational abilities.
- The applicant has the time, personal commitment and support of their institution to serve IPAC Canada through this position.

One (1) Novice ICP for a One Year Term - IPAC Canada is seeking a Novice member of the Education Core Committee. The candidate will have less than two years' experience in infection prevention and control and will have been a member of IPAC Canada for at least one year. The position commences July 1, 2017 and ends on June 30, 2018.

Qualifications:

- The applicant has been a member of IPAC Canada for at least one year.
- Current Certification in Infection Control (CIC®) is not mandatory for this position.
- Membership must be maintained in good standing during the term of this position.
- The applicant will have less than two years' experience in infection prevention and control.
- Experience in the development of education opportunities is helpful but not mandatory.
- The applicant will have experience with working as a team member, with strong collaboration, communication and organizational abilities.
- The applicant has the time, personal commitment and support of their institution to serve IPAC Canada through this position.

APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE:

- A letter from applicant indicating they are applying to be the Experienced or Novice representative on the IPAC Canada Education Core Committee.
- The letter will indicate the applicant's interest and demonstrate suitability for the position.
- The letter must include an outline of professional expertise, education and teaching experience.

- A current curriculum vitae.
- A letter from the candidate`s institution indicating support for the candidate`s application for the position.

Applications must be received no later than **May 31, 2017**.
