IPAC CANADA proudly announces the launch of the IPAC Canada Learning Object Repository (LOR). The LOR will contain collections of digital learning objects developed by members of IPAC Canada for teaching and for learning. Following is a call for submissions to the site.

Contributing a learning object

You are invited to contribute a learning object to share with IPAC Canada members by logging in via the LOR button on the IPAC Canada Home Page of its website (registration required for first time users) and accessing the application form and upload prompts. Learning objects will be reviewed by an evaluation panel before posting. Postings will remain up for a two year period at which time they will be removed and the author(s) requested to review and revise before submitting for another evaluation and posting. **The deadline dates for submission of learning objects are May 1, 2016 and October 1, 2016.**

Once objects are selected by the review committee they will be available for reuse by IPAC Canada members under the terms of the Canadian Creative Commons Attribution Non-commercial ShareAlike 4.0 International (CC BY-NC-SA 4.0) license, except where otherwise stated. IPAC Canada members may utilize objects for their own educational purposes and leave a comment describing their success with the object and any recommendations for improvement. Additional announcements will be made as learning objects are available for use.
