

EXHIBITING DETAILS

Exhibiting Fee: \$2000 + GST (5%)

Fee includes:

- A draped exhibit space with a table and two chairs. Other amenities can be purchased through the show services provider. Exhibitor Service Manual will be available at a later date
- Booth sizes available are 10' x 10' only.
- Exhibitor name badges for two (2) individuals working at the booth will be provided. The name badges will give the exhibitor representatives access to education sessions; Sunday Opening Reception; Monday and Tuesday Lunches; and all breaks. Exhibitors must register separately for Wednesday events.
- Virtual exhibitor profile in the conference app.

Note: All exhibit booths must be approved by the organizers. The organizers reserve the right to restrict any items that may impede attendee or exhibitor sight lines.

Booth space is assigned based on the following criteria:

- 1. Corporate Members of IPAC Canada (according to 2024-2025 membership level)
- 2. Conference Sponsors (according to sponsorship level)
- 3. Previous IPAC Canada Exhibitors
- 4. Application Submission Date

Additional Booth Representative Registrations: \$200/each

Tickets for social events must be purchased separately.

CANCELLATION POLICY AND FAILURE TO OCCUPY SPACE

In the event that the balance due for booth rental is not remitted by February 24, 2025, the committee has the exclusive right to cancel the agreement with the exhibitor.

In the event of the committee receiving written notification on or before February 24, 2025, IPAC Canada shall refund the exhibitor payment, less an administration fee of \$500 per booth plus applicable tax.

For cancellations received after February 24, 2025, the entire payment shall be forfeited by the exhibitor unless the committee is able to re-sell the booth space under similar terms and conditions, in which case the exhibitor shall only forfeit an administration fee of \$500 plus applicable tax.

In the event that space is not occupied per agreement at the close of exhibit installation, the exhibitor shall forfeit all payments.




