



## REQUEST FOR RECOMMENDATIONS FOR BOARD NOMINEES

The Nominating Committee of the Board of Directors of IPAC Canada is charged with the responsibility of ensuring leadership continuity by nominating a slate of officers for open positions. The Nominating Committee's purpose and process are outlined in Policy 12.10 in the Members Area at <a href="www.ipac-canada.org">www.ipac-canada.org</a>. The Nominating Committee is requesting recommendations for candidates. Candidates can express interest directly or be recommended by another member. This is a suggestion of candidates who could be considered for nomination by the Nominating Committee, not an official nomination. All recommendations will be kept confidential. The Nominating Committee will review all recommendations and also undertake its own investigation of suitable candidates for open positions. The Nominating Committee reserves the right to decide which suggested candidates will be contacted. The final selection of candidates is at the discretion of the Nominating Committee and ratified by the Board of Directors. <a href="Additional nominees from the IPAC">Additional nominees from the IPAC</a> Canada membership are welcomed and encouraged after the Nominating Committee announces its slate of candidates.

Timelines for Election of Officers and Directors:

•	August 16, 2019	Deadline for expression of interest or suggestions for candidates
•	December 16, 2019	Announcement of the IPAC Canada Nominating Committee slate of candidates
•	February 14, 2020	Deadline for additional nominations from membership
•	February 28, 2020	Announcement of slate of candidates for election at Annual General Meeting (AGM)
•	April 2020 (date tba)	Q&A session with candidates and IPAC membership
•	May 6, 2020	AGM/Elections; late nominations will be accepted at the AGM*

• May 6, 2020 Board Orientation following AGM

\*According to the Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act and the IPAC Canada by-laws, additional nominations may be received at the AGM. The candidate must be proposed by two nominees and accept the nomination. Note that this procedure is required by law. The drawback is that members have not been afforded the opportunity to evaluate the late nominee's expertise while other candidates have put in the effort to inform members of their background and expertise, nor have they had the opportunity to obtain employer endorsement

The following positions are open for election on May 6, 2020:

- One (1) Director (Education) for a three year term commencing May 6, 2020
- One (1) Director (Chapters and Interest Groups) for a three year term commencing May 6, 2020.
- One (1) Secretary/Director (Membership) for a three year term commencing May 6, 2020

Position descriptions, including responsibilities and time commitment, are available in the Policy Manual in the Members Area at <a href="https://www.ipac-canada.org">www.ipac-canada.org</a>, along with requirements for Board membership.

## **Important Notes for Prospective Candidates**

- 1. <u>If confirmed</u> as a candidate for a Board position by the Nominations Committee, submit a high resolution colour head and shoulder professional photo no later than November 1, 2019.
- 2. If nominated for a Board position by an IPAC Canada member, <u>after the Board slate of candidates is announced</u>, submit a high resolution colour head and shoulder professional photo no later than February 14, 2020.
- 3. If elected, Directors must immediately resign from Chapter Executive position(s).
- 4. A Board Orientation will be held in the afternoon following elections at the Annual General Meeting. Please note that IPAC Canada does not provide travel or accommodation assistance for candidates or newly elected Board members to attend the Board Orientation.
