During deployment, the duty station may change, and duties may be modified, based upon the technical needs of the Programme.

- 1. Ensure that supportive supervision/mentorship is effective at preventing and controlling EVD nosocomial transmission and healthcare worker infection at healthcare facilities and improving IPC practices
- 2. Conduct Health Care Facility (HCF) assessments/evaluations and use results to guide plans for continuous improvement of IPC standards implementation and quality assurance
- 3. In collaboration with MOH and other IPC team members, develop/upgrade standardized evaluation tools and data system (including indicators) for monitoring and evaluating supportive IPC supervision and quality assurance
- 4. Advise/train MOH and/or IPC implementing partners on how to undertake supportive supervision and quality improvement projects as required
- 5. Support WHO DRC IPC team as required, including performing any other related incident-specific duties.
